Government Employee FREE

Department of Defense (DOD) civilian employees, appointed to the federal civil service across the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, and Coast Guard as well as other defense agencies with critical roles in aircraft maintenance, sustainment, operations, logistics, and other life cycle management programs.

U.S. Military/Active Duty FREE

Active-duty and reserve members of the United States Armed Forces from all branches ranking as NCOs, lieutenants, captains, majors, colonels, and general officers with critical roles in aircraft maintenance, sustainment, operations, logistics, and other life cycle management programs.

Industry \$200 (\$300 after November 10)

Private sector companies with active and leading positions in the defense industrial base sector that enable R&D, as well as design, production, delivery, and maintenance of military aircraft systems, subsystems, components or parts, and services that are essential to mobilize, deploy, and sustain military aviation operations to meet U.S. military requirements. *This does not include the commercial infrastructure of service providers such as power, communications, transportation, or utilities that the Department of Defense uses to meet military operational requirements.

Academia \$100 (\$200 after November 10)

Leading private-sector universities and other academic institutions with active Defense-University partnerships that facilitate innovation and collaboration with DoD lab scientists and DoD-funded academics to address long-term DoD basic research needs to fill capability gaps, generate patents, bring in human capital to the defense research enterprise, and build stronger relationships with academic researchers.




